Camp Luther Trip:

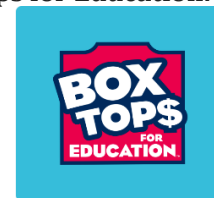

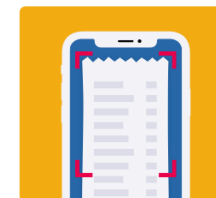
