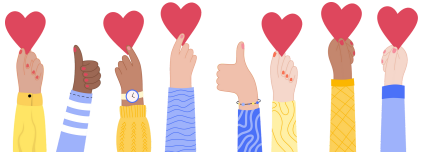


# PTL EVENT INFO 2023/24

## 1. Carnival Day

Carnival games are put on by the older students in the school. Helpers shop and serve lunch. We try to serve a healthy yet fun carnival/fair inspired lunch. Younger siblings not attending school are welcome to attend the "carnival" as well with parents supervision.



## 2. Movie Night



Movie night has been run several different ways based on parental involvement. If the kids stay right after school the group plans games or a scavenger hunt and snack for after school. When parents arrive supper is served and the movie starts. This is a family event and you are expected to chaperone your children thru out the event.



## 3. Santas Workshop

We work with a company that sends items for a Christmas "shop". We set up the store after school the evening before.
